


The good news about the new, solid state voltage regulators for your Huey is that they are more reliable and need less maintenance.

If you can't lay your hands on a couple for your bird, tho, you should at least have 1 installed as the main regulator. You can continue to use the old carbon pile type as the standby.



Now for the bad news: Some mechs are using outdated parts pubs when going for a replacement.

For the solid state job, ask for Voltage Regulator, NSN 6110-00-598-2567, listed in Fig 278 of TM 55-1520-210-23P (Mar 77).
