# Cork in Drag Braces



THESE DRAG BRACES ARE SUPPOSED TO HAVE CORK, RIGHT?

CORK'S NOT  
REQUIRED!**

**S**ome drag braces come corked, some don't. But cork is not required or authorized. Originally, cork was installed to keep out moisture. Now it's known that it picks up moisture and contributes to corrosion.

If you get corked braces, remove the cork. If your installed braces have cork, there's no requirement to remove it.
